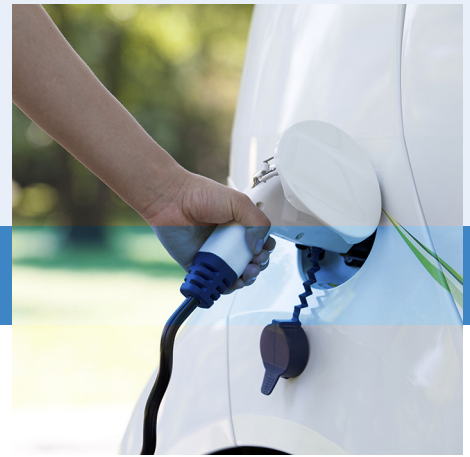


Electric Vehicle Familiarisation Course
