 - Practice drive
 - Final feedback and embedding of new techniques
 - Route planning
-  Highway Code is issued and key learning points discussed
-  Focus on new road types and regulations as required
-  Instill the key principles of Advanced Defensive Driving (Roadcraft / Business Driver)
-  Focus on key risk areas of UK roads
 - Roundabouts
 - Pedestrian crossings
 - Motorway law
